Working alongside families

Being a parent has never been easy. It can be lonely, frustrating, and over-whelming.

Life-changing events can happen to anyone. All parents struggle at one time or another. That is why Home-Start is available to support families at all times.

Home-Start volunteers support families with individual one-to-one home-visiting and a wide range of targeted support for parents and their children.

Home-Start works with families experiencing challenges including:

- Poor Mental or Physical Health
- Postnatal Depression Bereavement
- Financial Worries
- Managing Children's Behaviour

Just two hours support a week can make a big difference to a parent and their children.

We work with families to build on their strengths and give them the support they tell us they need.

Other types of support that we offer:

The Jigsaw Project Supporting Parents/carers of children with complex needs.

The Perinatal Project

Support through pregnancy until child is 2 years.

Parent & Toddler Group A weekly drop in for parents and toddlers

aged 0-4 years.

Holiday Allsorts Family activity days during school holidays .

Counselling Service Adult and child 1-1 Counselling service.

Time for Me Therapeutic sessions for adults.

Cook-A-Long with Home-Start 5 week cooking course.
